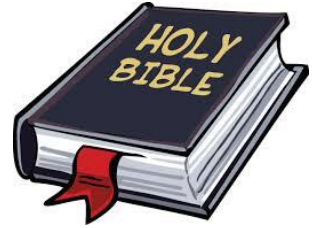




**DEAR PARENTS**

we praise God for enabling us to meet after what seems like a forever virtual church meeting. We are aware of those people who do not feel comfortable to attend the church service in person and this is our attempt to come alongside of you. We hope and pray that attending worship service as a family, at home, as well as in church has been an amazing learning experience for your family. In our attempt to assist you to follow today's teaching, we have suggested the following ...

Before you sit down to follow the worship service, encourage your child to listen attentively, participate in the singing, prayer, and Bible reading. One way to do this is to let each person in the family have a Bible of their own, even those who cannot read. When there is a chapter, or a verse to be read, let those who can read find the verse/the chapter and read. This would help them to be familiar with the books of the Bible. Help the younger ones who cannot read find the scripture reading and let them hold it while the others read. It would create a desire to want to know their Bible.



Another way to help your family actively participates in the service is to encourage the older kids to take notes and the younger ones to use the coloring picture that you will find on the next page or to draw a picture of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. This morning, Pastor Arnell will teach us from 2 Corinthians 2:12-17; The Life Marked by the Victory: "Our Triumph".

At the end of the teaching, before you close with prayer, if the children have not understood the message, the following questions will help to revise the main points. Both the **REVIEWING** and **APPLICATION** questions are suggestions. You can use all, a couple, or none.

Why did Paul worry in this chapter? (he could not find Titus, his friend)

When he was worried what truth brought comfort to his heart? (the victory that God had shared with us through His Son Jesus Christ's death on the cross and His resurrection. Our Triumph: the fact that God led us through the triumphal procession)

What did remembering/ celebrating this fact/victory inspired in Paul's life? (commitment to follow Christ & to be His

Can you believe that God is big enough to get you through the current troubles?

Can you believe that God is who He says He is and yet still wants to use you to speak for Him?

Can you believe that His Spirit dwells in you to make you a sweet fragrance of Christ?

Can you believe you can reflect His glory in your situation- your impossibility?

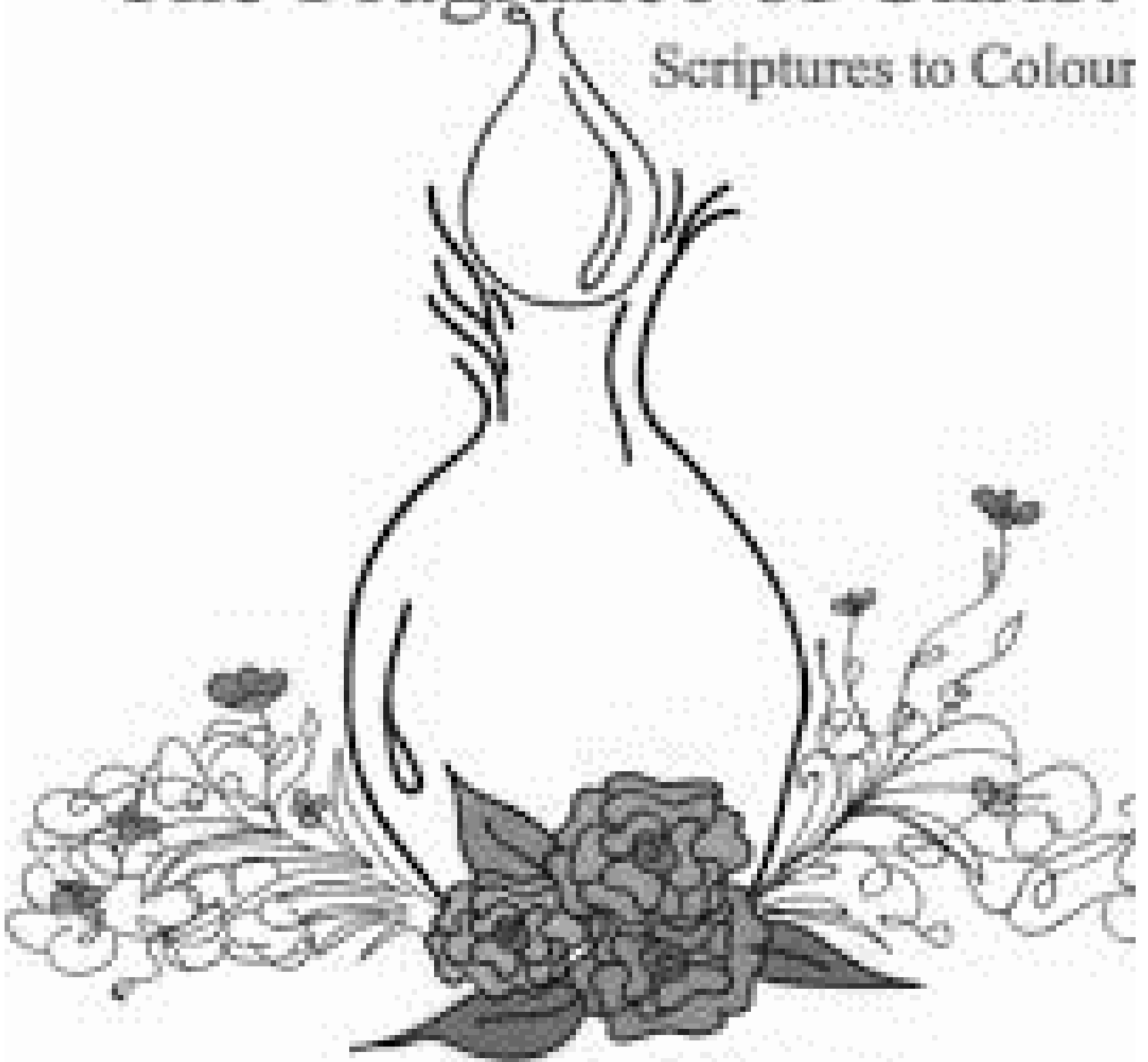
