REVIEW QUESTIONS (Read Luke 2:8-14)



What are the three reasons mentioned as to why Christmas brings us JOY? (God is with us, God is for us, & God is our Peace) You might want to discuss on each of the above points.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- Discuss the different circumstances that make you sad or put you down presently. (as a family and individually) How should knowing the fact that: God is with you, God is for you and God is your Peace change your attitude and help you to experience the Joy of Christmas?
- Pray as a family for God to show you a person who needs to hear the message of the Joy of Christmas and share the Good News!

Discuss and Memorize Isaiah 9:1-7 individually and have a family contest.
