

# Online Sermon Guide for Families



DEAR  
PARENTS

Today, Dr. Alemseged Ketema will teach us from Deuteronomy Chapter 7 about the gift that God has given us - His faithfulness.

Before the service begins, when you are getting ready to worship, it would be good to encourage your children to follow the worship service attentively: praying, participating in singing and listening attentively to the Bible teaching.

Please, tell your children that Dr. Alemseged will use some big words. Words that we do not usually use in our everyday language. Words like, **attribute**, the **three Omnis**, **immanent** to describe some of God's characters. Encourage them to take notes of the words and their meanings and later you can discuss them.

If the children have not understood the message, the following questions will help to revise the main points. Both the **REVIEW** and **APPLICATION** questions are suggestions. You can use all, a couple, or none.

## REVIEW QUESTIONS (read Deuteronomy 7)



What do we mean when we say God is faithful? **(We are saying- God is reliable, constant, dependable...)**

How can we be sure that God is faithful?  
**(He is Omniscience-He knows everything;  
He is Omnipotent -He can do all things; He is  
Omnipresent- He is always present)**

What are the three things that we need to remember about God's faithfulness? **(God is faithful: in our difficulty, in our blessings, and because of Who He is and not because of what we have done)**

How should we respond? **(We respond with our gratitude and praise, out of our obedience and confidence)**

## APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- Remember the faithfulness of God in your personal and family life that you have experienced- share with one another and praise God for it.
- Pray that God will help you to remember with confidence that He is a faithful God all the time (in your trouble and joyous time and to help you live out an obedient life)



## TO HELP YOUR CHILDREN FOLLOW ATTENTIVELY

Let each person in the family have a Bible of their own, even those who cannot read.

Encourage the older kids to take notes and the younger ones to use the coloring pictures that you will see at the end of the
