## Sunday, January 17 - Ruth 1:1-18

1. What was the time of the Judges like in the beginning of Ruth?
2. Why do you think Elimelech and Naomi fled during the famine? How do we do the same thing?
3. What is repentance? And what do you learn about repentance from Naomi?
4. Why do you think Naomi discouraged Orpah and Ruth from following her?
5. What do you learn about counting the cost of following from Ruth?
6. What other applications did you get from the sermon and text?

## Sunday, January 24 - Ruth 1:19-2:13

1. What made Boaz a worthy man? What are some places we wrongly look for worth?
2. How is Boaz a picture of the coming Messiah?
3. How do we discover God's will for our lives? How do we misunderstand God's will?
4. Why do we struggle to trust God and walk by faith?
5. What other applications did you get from the sermon and text?

## Sunday, February 7 - Ruth 2:14-23

1. What other applications did you get from the sermon and text?
2. How have you experienced God's loving kindness in the midst of tragedy and crisis?
3. How do we know God is working for His Glory and our good even in time of trouble?
4. Husband, why do men often fail to serve their wives well? How can you serve your wife well?
